Fundraising/Volunteering Information - Mooretown Lady Flags 2023/24 Season

Mooretown Lady Flags Girls Hockey Association is run by volunteers. Our organization actively fundraisers throughout the year, including the off season, to help offset costs like registration, ice, and referee fees. As a parent/guardian of a Lady Flags player, you are expected to complete 8 hours of volunteer work.

Every family that is registered with our organization must submit a \$500 post dated volunteer and jersey cheque; this includes coaches, team staff, and members of the Executive. Cheques must be post dated for May 1, 2024. All cheques must be submitted to their teams' manager by October 1, 2023.

Please note:

- Cheques and volunteer/jersey forms not submitted by October 1, 2023 will result in the player not being permitted to skate.
- If the 8 volunteer hours are not completed per family, the cheque will be cashed.
- If jerseys are not returned to the head coach in a timely fashion **and** in good condition, then the cheque will be cashed.

Volunteer Changes for 2023/24 Season

- 1. ONE bingo representative per team. The bingo representative will need to complete a short online training and complete at least four bingos throughout the season. The bingo representative will be supplied with a shirt, will need to wear black pants, and black shoes. Only one person can be the bingo representative due to number constraints. Bingos are our biggest source of income and greatly offset our costs (approximately \$200 a player). Without bingos, fees will go up. We hope that all members will support this. There are two bingos each month, two representatives are needed at each bingo. Bingos run 12 months a year. - 2. Time clock/scoresheet hours count towards the 8 hour requirement, as long as the volunteers cover at least 75% of their teams games.
