



**Arena Processes:**

1. Ensure your player goes to the washroom prior to getting all equipment on and arriving at arena. Players can get equipment on in parking lot if you wish (skates, helmet, gloves can be carried into arena in small duffle bag). Goalies may enter with regular bag and get ready in change room given the size of their gear. Ensure the parent has reviewed the screening questionnaire with the player and for and answers are sufficient to pass arena screening process. Reminder - Reporting to the arena for practice/game tells the Covid Designate that both the player & parent/guardian has passed the Lady Flag Covid Screening Questionnaire.
2. Covid designate and rostered coaches should arrive to arena 20 minutes prior to session so Covid designate can get set up, take attendance and direct players to appropriate dressing room. Coaches need to be spread among the 3 dressing rooms assigned. Covid designate should direct coaches to appropriate room so rooms are not over loaded.
3. When head coach and Covid Designate arrives, he/she is to advise the arena screeners that they will be ensuring that all Covid rules are adhered to the best of their abilities.
4. Please have child ready to enter the arena 15 minutes prior to your ice time. Any earlier and you may have to wait to enter, any later and you may not have enough time to get through the following steps to hit the ice on time. Once approved to move through, ice participants will need to go directly towards the dressing rooms.
5. Everyone wears masks until they enter the ice surface accept the kids can remove in dressing room once helmet is being strapped up, they will maintain social distance in the room by staying on their X.





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**NEW – Mooretown Arena Rules**

Covid Designate Responsibilities

- 1) MUST be the first one to arrive at the arena (20 minutes prior to practice/game time) – should they not be there – no one else can enter the arena until they come. Arena staff will no longer allow players in until a Covid designate is present.
- 2) MUST check in with the arena staff – they must tell them who they are before opening the arena for the use by the rest of the squad
- 3) Designate – will take attendance and assign the dressing room to assure there are not too many kids per room; 1 coach per room (*suggestion – assign same kids/coaches in each dressing room each time for ease of process*).
- 4) Each squad will be given 3 dressing rooms for their ice session. Rooms 1 to 3 or Rooms 4 to 6. There will be X's on the dressing room benches where the children must sit. Only 8 participants will be permitted in each dressing room. The maximum occupancy per room is 8 total in all rooms except room 5 where only 7 total is the maximum. Parents in room to tie skates must stand in front of child if waiting for child to go on ice. If not they must move to the designated viewing area in the stands.

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**NEW – Walpole Arena Rules**

Covid Designate Responsibilities

- 1) Designate – will take attendance and assign the dressing room to assure there are not too many kids per room (*suggestion – assign same kids/coaches in each dressing room each time for ease of process*)
  - 2) Given the size of the dressing rooms – players **MUST** come dressed and enter arena completed dressed with **ONLY** skates, helmets and gloves to apply to decrease the time required in change room. We must not go over the capacity of the dressing room amount. If the capacity is reached – the player is to put skates and helmet outside the change room area. This will be monitored by the designate. Dressing Room 1 & 2 will be designated to players for skate tying only (MAX – 7 per room)
  - 3) *Goalies* – can bring in bag but will be in separate dressing room – Dressing Room 5 will be designated to them

**Rink 1 Dressing room Capacity:**
