

Mooretown Sports Complex Restrictions while in Red

- 1. Rink 1 is the only rink open and no access to dressing rooms.
- 2. 1 guardian allowed per player 17 years of age and younger.
- 3. Upon entry, the Arena Staff will screen parents and players. Players will only be permitted to enter when the prior team as exited the facility.
- 4. Face coverings are required by everyone including skaters. Skaters masks may come off when they are ready to go on the ice.
- Players come fully dressed. There will be a space at front of Rink 1 for guardians to tie skates NO BAGS permitted. Goalies are to carry skates and pads in. Come wearing all gear – including helmet.
- 6. 10 skaters and 2 coaches/trainer on the ice only.
- 7. After training, skaters required to quickly remove skates and leave building via exit door near room 5. Once all have exited, next group comes in while they are flooding and gets skates on.
- 8. Guardians are permitted to stand in the stands. Strict physical distancing of 6 feet MUST be maintained. Once you are in the facility if you leave you will not be allowed to re-enter doors will be locked.
- 9. Equipment must NOT be shared between user groups.
- 10. Maintain strict **2 metres** physical distancing both on and off the ice and no scrimmaging/games are to be played.
- 11. Coaches/Trainers please push the players to get off the ice quickly and leave so the next group can come in. No one will be allowed in the arena until the other team is out.
- 12. No Food or Drink will be permitted in the facility.
- 13. All user groups are required to maintain COVID information transparency with St. Clair Township Department of Community Services. Names are not required but any direction from Public Health given to Executive, coaches, or players to self-isolate or any positive test results must be shared with the Coordinator of Facilities as soon as possible.
