Return to Play – Mooretown Sports Complex

Guidance for Arena Users (Parents, Caregivers and Children)

As we continue to open we want to inform all of our users of some of the rules and regulations; these rules and regulations will be strictly enforced by staff and the user groups in which you are associated with.

1. Physical Distancing within the Facility is always required and enforced.
2. We ask that masks or face coverings are worn while in the facility.
3. Be respectful to the staff always – If the staff were not here to enforce the screening processes and rules than we would be forced to CLOSE the Mooretown Sports Complex based on COVID 19 Provincial Guidelines.
4. The Mooretown Sports Complex has allowed 6 volunteers to come in with their associations to assist with ensuring the rules are being followed and to assist any of their skaters during their rental times.
5. The Mooretown Sports Complex has allowed 1 parent for each child in U9 & U11 to come in and assist with tying skates before their skate time. The Mooretown Sports Complex is under very strict guidelines from the Public Health Unit to ensure that physical distancing is maintained by all patrons within our facility; therefore we must stress that the 1 parent we have allowed to tie skates must enter the facility with the skater and although we realize it is not ideal any **additional children will not be permitted** to enter the facility at this time. Each of our designated areas have been measured to ensure physical distancing and at this time any unauthorized additions will cause our facility to be over the calculated numbers.

Failure to comply with the above rules will result in the following:

1. You and your participant will be asked to leave the facility.
2. A team or group may be asked to immediately leave the facility without refund if rules are consistently not being followed by teams/groups AND individuals.
3. A team, group or individual may be suspended for a length of time without refund.
4. An individual may be suspended indefinitely from the facility.
5. Failure to comply with the above rules may result in the postponement of Spectator Allowance.

We have been working diligently to continue to open and offer more services to our Community – please help us continue to move forward by respecting and adhering to the rules and regulations which we must follow in order to continue to stay open and operating.
